CHAIRMAN'S CHALLENGE 2011-2012

24th April 2012

This year's challenge will consist of each entrant submitting 2 separate images*, both on the same subject of the entrant's choice. One image should be a "traditional" rendition of the subject and the other a "creative" rendition. The images will be displayed in tandem so that they can be directly compared.

Each image will be individually judged and awarded a score out of 25 points; with the emphasis of the scoring being based on the individuality and interpretation of the subject by the entrant, the appeal of the image and its presentation, as well as the normal competition criteria of composition, lighting and image quality. The pair of images will also be scored, again out of 25, dependant on the merits of the interpretations of the subject. The winner will be the entrant whose aggregate score is the highest.

Each entrant may make up to 2 different entries. Individual images shall not have been used in any previous competition and the entry shall include the name of the Entrant, the title of the pair of images and the chosen subject. Each entrant's images and titles, and the subject chosen for them, shall be submitted one week before the date of the competition.
